Laborer, Part-time

GRADE CLASSIFICATION: G6-1
Starting Salary: \$8.29 hour
FLSA: Part-time position

EMPLOYEE BENEFITS: No benefits for part-time personnel.

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES: Hours worked per week will depend on the needs of the Department. Person will typically work between two and five days per week. This person will act as a carrier on a packer truck collecting solid waste containers and depositing the contents of containers into a collection vehicle, and returning containers to prescribed area. Make special collections as assigned such as special pickups and yard waste. Be observant of surrounding conditions such as citizens, equipment, property, etc. in order to assure that solid waste is collected in a safe manner. Regulate traffic in hazardous conditions in order to assure safety conditions for the collection personnel and the general public. Wash collection vehicles. Perform all duties in conformance to appropriate safety and security standards. Other duties as assigned.

MINIMUM EDUCATION: Must be able to read and write.

SPECIAL QUALIFICATIONS: Must be able to perform a variety of unskilled and semi-skilled work, and operate a variety of equipment in the collection of solid waste. Must have the ability to establish and maintain an effective working relationship with the public and other city employees.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS: Must be in excellent physical condition and be able to withstand extreme weather conditions. The employee must frequently lift and/or move up to 50 pounds and occasionally lift and/or move 100 pounds. The employee is regularly required to use hands to finger, handle, or feel objects, tools, or controls and reach with hands and arms. The employee is frequently required to stand, talk, or hear. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and the ability to adjust focus.
