

The Japanese Tree Lilac's popularity has skyrocketed over the last several years and with good reason. It is versatile enough to use in numerous settings, requires little maintenance, is pest resistant, and puts on quite a show when it flowers. If your landscape calls for a small tree with a big impact, this plant is the perfect candidate.

"Tree Lilac" is somewhat of a misnomer. This specimen can be grown as both a tree or as the more traditional shrub. Regardless of the plants shape, the white flowers that form from early June to July have been described as giving the tree the appearance of being surrounded by a cloud. Large plumes can reach 12" in length and up to 10" wide. The reddish cherry-like bark and dark green leaves provide a nice contrast to the creamy blooms. While not the hallmark of this tree, the green fruit clusters can be somewhat showy if viewed at close range.
