



Construction Dumpster Guidelines and Fees

- 4 YD** = \$73.00 each time emptied + \$5.00 per day rent (5'Wx7'Lx4'D) **\$73 Deposit**
6 YD = \$99.50 each time emptied + \$5.00 per day rent (5'Wx10'Lx4'D) **\$99.50 Deposit**
10 YD = \$90.00 each time emptied + \$5.00 per day rent + \$42.56 per ton (7'x10'x4') **\$125 Deposit**
20 YD = \$90.00 each time emptied + \$5.00 per day rent + \$42.56 per ton (7'x20'x4') **\$125 Deposit**
30 YD = \$90.00 each time emptied + \$5.00 per day rent + \$42.56 per ton (7'x20'x6') **\$125 Deposit**
Dry Run Fee/Dumpster blocked fee: \$40.00 Fee to relocate/move a dumpster: \$40.00

The City is not responsible for damage caused while dropping off or picking up dumpster or for accidents which occur while the dumpster is rented to a customer.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- 1) Dumpsters must be level full or we cannot empty them.**
- 2) Customers are prohibited from moving dumpsters with heavy equipment and will be held liable for damage to dumpsters. Please call office to have dumpster moved.**
- 3) LARGE PIECES OF CONCRETE ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE. Loads rejected by the Transfer Station will be direct hauled to Cuba landfill at an additional cost of \$100.00.**

NOT ACCEPTABLE in 4 yard and 6 yard dumpsters:

- Appliances (washer, dryer, stove, refrigerator, water heater, humidifier, etc.)
- Tires
- Yard waste (limbs, grass clippings, leaves, etc.)
- Heavy remodeling debris: sheet rock, ceramic tile, etc.
- Paint, stain, varnish, etc. if still in liquid form (if dried out and lid left off it can be put in dumpster)
- Car batteries (lead/acid batteries)
- Long pieces of lightweight pipe or tubing (short pieces are acceptable)
- Heavy pieces of metal (I-beams, structural steel, automobile motors, car parts, etc.)
- Concrete, bricks, blocks, rocks, etc.
- Absolutely **NO** chemicals, hazardous or special/regulated wastes, used oil or other liquids

NOT ACCEPTABLE in 10, 20 or 30 yard dumpsters:

- Appliances (washer, dryer, stove, refrigerator, water heater, humidifier, etc.)
- Tires
- Yard waste (limbs, grass clippings, leaves, etc.)
- Paint, stain, varnish, etc. if still in liquid form (if dried out and lid left off it can be put in dumpster)
- Car batteries (lead/acid batteries)
- **Overfilling past the fill line shown on dumpster**
- Absolutely **NO** chemicals, hazardous or special/regulated wastes, used oil or other liquid wastes
- **If used for concrete, rock, dirt, etc. a 20 yard is the MAXIMUM size allowed. *See notation #3 above.**
