GRADE CLASSIFICATION: G3 (minimum starting pay at \$7.664/hr.)

SHIFT AVAILABLE: Days, evenings & weekends. Varied hours and shifts available from 5:30 AM to 9:00 PM. Older adults encouraged to apply for 5:30 AM to 1:00PM shift, 2 to 3 days a week. Work schedule may be scheduled around classes and/or other duties/activities. 15 to 28 hours per week. Employee may work at the Centre and/or SplashZone.

FLSA: Part-Time, Non-Exempt

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES:

Prevent aquatic emergencies, provide rescue and emergency care, assist in facility supervision and operations, and provide the highest of care for facilities guest. Lifeguard(s) will train and prepare for aquatic emergencies under the American Red Cross guidelines and "Standard of Care" for aquatic facilities. Other duties as assigned.

EDUCATION/TRAINING:

American Red Cross Lifeguard Training. Combination of education and experience that provides knowledge, skills and abilities will be considered.

SPECIAL QUALIFICATIONS:

Perform CPR and First aid, use of AED and oxygen administration. Pass American Red Cross written exam for Life Guarding with Water Park with 80%.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS:

Ability to swim 500 yards using crawl stroke 200 yards, breaststroke 100 yards and combination 200 yards. Swim 20 yards then do a Feet First surface dive to 8 feet and retrieve a 10-pound brick from bottom, then swim back to starting point with brick. Tread water for 1 minute. Ability to see distances and underwater. Walk and sit at guard stations. Ability to pull and remove persons from the water.
