

## **JOB ANNOUNCEMENT**

### **ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT**

#### **Laborer**

GRADE CLASSIFICATION: G9  
Starting Wage: \$14.14 per hour

FLSA: Full time non-exempt

EMPLOYEE BENEFITS: Family health and dental insurance plan, life insurance, excellent pension plan, ten (10 ) paid holidays, one (1) personal holiday, two (2) weeks vacation after first year of employment, and twelve (12) sick days a year.

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES: Act as a carrier on designated collection routes, picking up solid waste containers, recyclables or yard waste as assigned, and depositing the contents of containers into a collection vehicle, and returning containers to prescribed area. Make special collections as assigned. Note variances in customers' services. Observe surrounding conditions such as citizens, equipment, property, etc. in order to assure that solid waste is collected in a safe manner. Regulate traffic in hazardous conditions in order to assure safety conditions for the collection personnel and the general public. Wash collection vehicles, containers and other equipment. Perform all duties in conformance to appropriate safety and security standards. Other duties as assigned.

MINIMUM EDUCATION: Must be able to read and write.

SPECIAL QUALIFICATIONS: Must be able to perform a variety of unskilled and semi-skilled work, and operate a variety of equipment in the collection of solid waste. Must have the ability to establish and maintain an effective working relationship with the public and other city employees.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS: Must be in good physical condition and be able to withstand extreme weather conditions. The employee must frequently lift and/or move up to 50 pounds and occasionally lift and/or move 100 pounds. The employee is regularly required to use hands to finger, handle, or feel objects, tools, or controls and reach with hands and arms. The employee is frequently required to stand, talk, or hear. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and the ability to adjust focus.
