

POST CERTIFIED POLICE OFFICER – SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER

GRADE CLASSIFICATION: Grade P4, Full-time, Non-exempt

Starting Salary Range: \$42,790 to \$45,397 estimated annually (includes holiday pay)
Candidate is an employee of the City, not of the Rolla Public School District.

EMPLOYEE BENEFITS:

Family health and dental insurance plan; life insurance; Custom Benefit Plan; eleven (11) paid holidays and one (1) personal holiday; two (2) weeks of vacation and twelve (12) sick days a year.

DESCRIPTION OF BASIC DUTIES:

The School Resource Officer (SRO) provides a highly visible presence in the Rolla Public Schools (RPS) to deter crime, identify trespassers on campus, help with safety issues including crowd and traffic control, create safe and drug free schools, promote healthy youth development, and be a liaison for the students, faculty, community, and law enforcement. SRO will foster educational programs/activities for students and faculty, attend extracurricular activities held at the schools, handle the primary responsibility of responding to calls for service and investigating crimes on RPS campuses, provide assistance to other officers/agencies in their investigations which involve students (on or off campus), act swiftly when responding to disruptions or criminal offenses on school grounds, provide direct intervention and resources to help youth who are experiencing traumatic or criminal situations, etc. When school is not in session (i.e. holidays, summer vacation, midyear breaks, etc.), the SRO will report to his/her supervisor for further assignment and may be required to perform routine duties required of a regular police officer.

EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS:

High school diploma or equivalent General Education Development Certificate (GED). Must be POST certified as a law enforcement officer in the state of Missouri by date of hire.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS:

Employee is frequently required to sit, walk, talk and hear; use hands to finger, handle, or feel objects, tools, or controls. Specific vision abilities required include close vision and the ability to adjust focus. Must occasionally lift and/or move up to 50 pounds. Must be able to operate an emergency vehicle in a safe and defensive manner.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

- < Must be a US citizen at least 21 years of age and possess a valid Missouri Driver's License at time of appointment.
- < Must successfully pass the following: Peer Board interview, Police Personnel Board interview, Chief's interview, psychological test, polygraph, background investigation, physical fitness test, physical & drug screen, and weapons qualification.
- < Traits to be considered in the selection include the candidate's willingness and ability to work with youth; the level of maturity, patience, industry, courtesy, tact, flexibility, approachability; and the candidate's verbal and written communication skills. A successful SRO must be a good role model for the youth of our community.
