PERMIT, RELEASE, AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

I, _____ of _____ in consideration of being granted permission to be assigned to a duty post or to ride in a City of Rolla vehicle and of accompanying a Rolla Police employee for the purpose of observing and becoming familiar with the operation of a Rolla Police employee in the actual performance of his duties or while performing an assigned task as an Explorer, do hereby release and discharge the City of Rolla, the Rolla Police Department and all personal representatives, now and forever, for all loss or damages in any claim or demands therefore on account of injury or other casualty to myself or my property, whether by negligence or otherwise, during such time that I may be in an automobile, other vehicle or duty post or while performing an assigned task as an Explorer of the Rolla Police Department or in the company of an employee of the Rolla Police Department for the above-mentioned purposes while said employee is officially discharging his duties.

I further assume all risk of death, injury, loss or damage to my person or property, whether due to negligence or otherwise, and neither myself nor any of my representatives shall have any right or claim against the City of Rolla, the Rolla Police Department, their officers or employees in respect or arising out of any such death, injury, loss, or damage.

I further hereby agree to indemnify and save harmless the City of Rolla, the Rolla Police Department, and all of their officers and employees on account of any debt, expense, claim, obligation, or any sum of money which they may be required to pay on account of any liability or damage by reason of any injury to me or damage to my property, whether by negligence or otherwise, while I may be in a Rolla Police Department automobile, other vehicle or in the company of a Rolla Police Officer while said officer is officially discharging his duties.

THE ROLLA POLICE EXPLORERS

(Common Questions and Answers)

- **What are the Rolla Police Explorers?**

The Rolla Police Explorers is a branch of the Boy Scouts, Post 170. Although it is a part of the Boy Scouts both males and females are welcome to join us.

- **What is the purpose of the Police Explorers?**

1. To further the Explorers' education, character building, and leadership development.
2. To provide members with the basic knowledge of the Law Enforcement field.
3. To serve as a community relations effort between police and the youth of the community.
4. To utilize as a service group within the community, to assist with security, crowd control, traffic control, and community service.
5. To enhance Explorer preparation for future roles as productive and active citizens and community members.
6. To provide supplemental support, allowing officers to concentrate on more important aspects.

- **What are the requirements to be an Explorer?**

1. Must be 15 years of age and must not exceed 20 years of age.
2. NO juvenile or adult criminal record.
3. Pass a background check.
4. Parental approval (if applies).
5. Completion of application.
6. Possess a high school diploma or GED or have a GPA equal to or above a "C" average.
7. A \$25.00 membership fee. This fee is an annual fee by the B.S.A.

- **How can I get involved?**

Come to our meetings (bi-weekly) on Saturday's at 09:00 am. The meetings are held at the Rolla Police Department Training Room.

- **What do we do at our meetings?**

Our meetings last for two hours and consist of training. We train in, but are **not limited** to, common law, investigations, unarmed self-defense, and firearms.

- **Is there any uniform that you have to wear?**

YES! We will provide the uniform IF we already have your size. If we don't we do expect that you purchase a uniform accommodating to our standards. This can be fairly inexpensive, so don't be worried.

- **Is there any interaction with the officers?**

After completion of necessary training you have the chance to ride-along with officers. When you do this you can ride anytime during the day or evening shifts. When you're riding along you have the opportunity to use the training you've been provided. You do not have the ability to arrest or carry a firearm.

- **How will this program help me in the future?**

The Explorer program is a way to get your foot in the door. If you want to become an officer you will still have to go to a police academy. The Explorer program is a condensed form of an academy. This program will help you in becoming a police officer. For persons who don't want to become law enforcement officers, but move into another type of public service field you gain a lot of knowledge and organization networking. The Explorer program will teach you many life essential skills.
